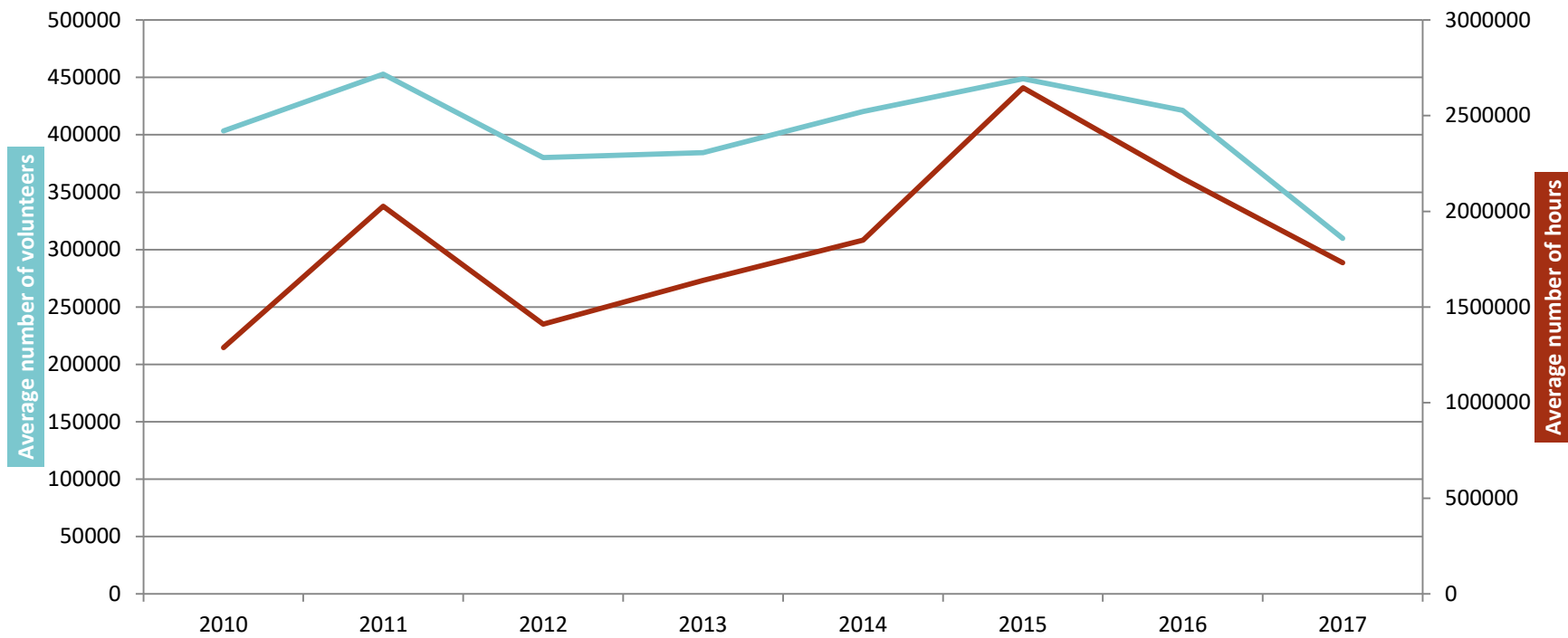


## Registered Charities' volunteers and volunteer hours

### Volunteers with Registered Charities

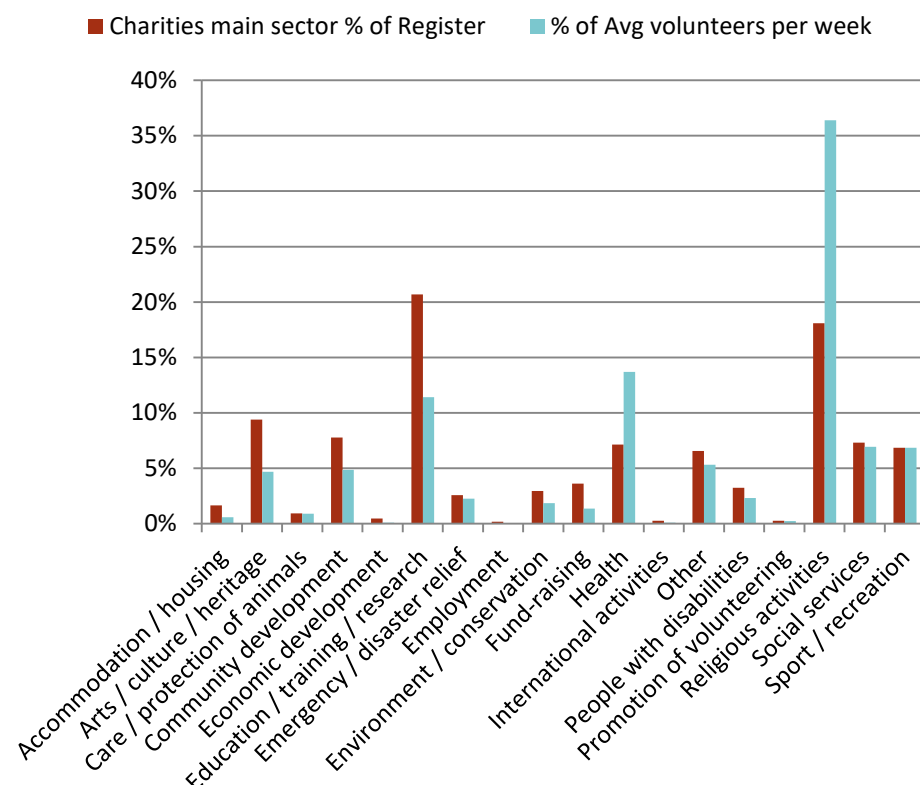
On average there are over 300,000 people volunteering for registered charities and contributing over 1.5 million hours every week.

Religious, educational and health charities had the highest numbers of volunteers reported in their most recent annual returns.

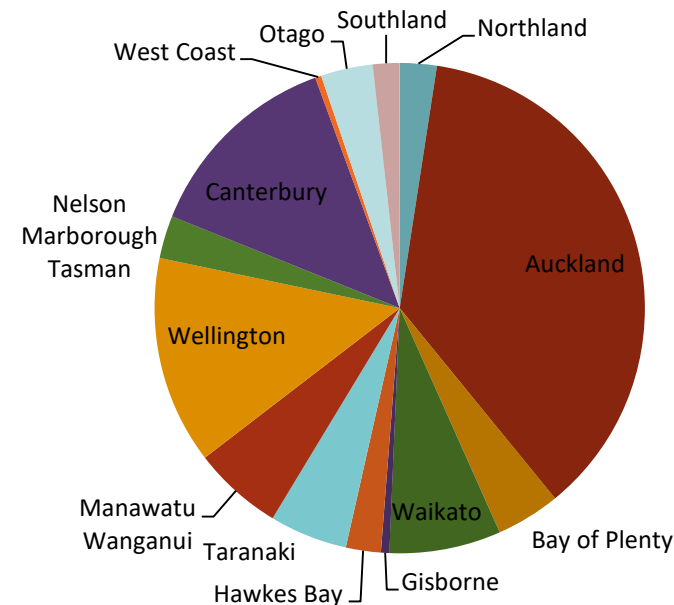
Between 2016 and 2017 there has been a noticeable decrease in the average number of volunteers and in the average number of hours volunteered.

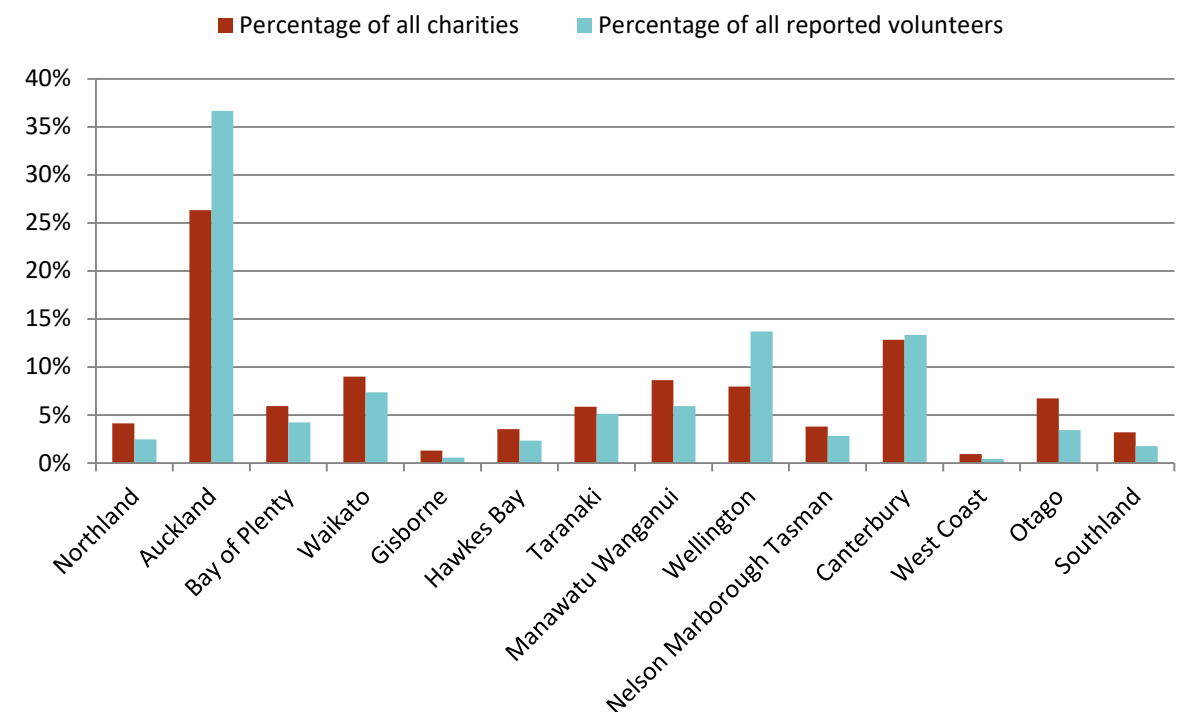
### Volunteers within each main sector
